Global business leaders gather at House of Parliament for Christmas networking event



Notable attendees included representatives from over 14 embassies and high commissions, former Chief Ministers, ex-MEPs, former England cricketers, and delegates from the British Army, London Assembly, Commonwealth Secretariat, and 10 Downing Street. Business leaders from various industries and international delegates from India, Poland, Turkey, and the UAE added to the evening's significance.

Andrew Grocock CEO of The Together UK Foundation and Chief of Staff of Baroness Arlene Foster, First Minister of Northern Ireland was one of those who enjoyed the event, and praised its success.

"Todays's event is so important because Together UK is all about connecting people, it's about keeping the United Kingdom together, it's about strengthening our ties through relationships and trade with countries, particularly from the Commonwealth," he said.

"India is the future. It has now surpassed the UK with regard to its position in the world GDP etc. We have a lot of relationships with Indian companies, we speak the same language, we have the same moral compass we're family orientated so I think India is our natural partner in the world and it's very important that we should strengthen that through ties and events like this.

"It's a fantastic event Taha of the Asian Business Council has done a fantastic job. I'm looking forward to doing this on an annual basis. I've met some wonderful people here, so it's been 100 per cent success," he added. Taha Coburn-Kutay set up the UK Asian Business Forum in 2014.

However, it's the first time the organisation has held its inaugural 'Rising Bharat Awards.'

"These are very special awards – recognising people who are doing very very hard work for the community, for their friends and for themselves," he said.

"The UK Asian Business Council, is all about how we can empower people – how we can empower the person who cannot be empowered. The whole idea is about how you connect people, and with those connections how are you able to help them achieve what they want.

"When I set up the council, it was a leap of faith but I knew that without taking a risk, you don't reap the rewards," he added.
